WHY GREEN SCHOOL?

For people in rural communities of Nepal, one of the biggest issues is the lack of access to quality education for their children. Most rural schools are financially constrained and lack suitable teaching resources and proper infrastructure to provide an optimum learning environment for the young children.

These communities are often the primary stakeholders and natural resource managers as they are located in close proximity of forests, watersheds and agricultural lands.

The goal of our Green School Project is to enrich the learning environment of the young children by working together with their schools and families.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

The core activities of the Green School Project are based on environment and education themes. These activities are integrated into the schools' curriculum from the very beginning of the academic calendar.

A field office is established in the community with project staffs who work with the schools to implement these activities. Eco-clubs and eco-committees are formed involving the students, teachers and community members to facilitate the process.

Green School Project at its heart, aims to nurture young minds by enhancing their learning experience so they can grow with a greater appreciation of the natural world, develop stronger bond with their friends and community, understand the importance of sustainability and gain confidence to chase their dreams.



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
